Parrish noted that there were two bids and Rapiscan Systems was the lowest but could not have the system here within less than 30 days as required by the grant, he did however note that Astrophysics could have the system here within 25 days. There was discussion with regards to which bid met the specifications. It was recommended that we go with Astrophysics since Rapiscan could not meet timely delivery required by the grant. Commissioner Wood motioned to accept the bid from Astrophysics for Courthouse Security X-ray machine Commissioner Blanks seconded the motion. It was **approved** by the “**I**” vote.

**STAFF REPORTS**

Attorney McCoy reminded everyone of the Public Hearing on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June at 3:45 p.m. just before the Commission Meeting; the Rules Ways and Means Committee meeting at his office on the 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10:30 a.m. EST with regards to a Financial review with Mr. Jolly (our investment banker), he stated that it is a committee meeting but would like to have as many commissioners come that could. He also stated that there is a docket call on a case that has been appealed from the Revenue Commissions Office regarding an assessment valuation on the Ford Mill apartments in Langdale, this will be on Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> they are asking for a jury trial.

County Engineer Josh Harvill stated that we owed some appreciation to ALDOT, they have installed the cross walk for the public parking on the Westside of the Courthouse, this was done at the request of the Commission and also a couple members of the public that live in LaFayette and possibly some Council members that had contacted them. By doing this know 431 may be resurfaced by the end of the summer as it is at this point it is not pretty nor is it permanent but would be soon and then some public parking signs would be put up. (Commissioner Wood asked why not employee parking and let the public park

around the courthouse). We are still working on CR 62 (Commissioner Brown asked that Josh explain the steps) they have just finished patching and will start widening the section between 77 & 53; once this is done a scrub seal will be placed and then will be spot leveled any ruff places and then surface. Attorney McCoy asked if this would go all the way from 77 to Marcoot and Engineer Harvill noted it would. Another thing to thank ALDOT for is they are working with us on the Lights at Exit 77.

**CHAIRMAN EASTRIDGE**

Chairman Eastridge informed everyone the next Commission meeting will be June 15<sup>th</sup>, and prior to that there will be a public hearing.

**Deadline to notify ADOR: July 7, 2015**

The 2015 "Back-to-School" Sales Tax Holiday begins at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, August 7, 2015, and ends at twelve midnight on Sunday, August 9, 2015. As required by Rule 810-6-3-.65, a participating county or municipality shall submit a certified copy of their adopted resolution or ordinance providing for the Sales Tax Holiday, and any subsequent amendments thereof, to the Alabama Department of Revenue before July 7, 2015. The Department will compile this information into a list of all counties and municipalities participating in the "Back-to-School" Sales Tax Holiday and issue a current publication of the list on its website at: [www.revenue.alabama.gov/salestax/SalesTaxHol.cfm](http://www.revenue.alabama.gov/salestax/SalesTaxHol.cfm). Notification of participation in the sales tax holiday may not be included in the published list if received after July 7, 2015.

**Your taxpayers need to know whether or not your locality will participate in the 2015 "Back-to-School" Sales Tax Holiday.**

**Please put it on your calendar to discuss and vote on this matter soon and notify the ADOR of the decision.**

**Participating?** Send a certified copy of any resolution, ordinance, or amendment adopted by your locality.

**Not Participating?** It is important that you inform us of that fact by email, fax or letter.

Taxpayers and retailers rely on the list provided by the Department of Revenue and the Department cannot post a locality's participation status based on assumption; notification of nonparticipation or copies of resolution/ordinance from the locality is required.

**RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CHAMBERS COUNTY'S  
PARTICIPATION IN THE "SALES TAX HOLIDAY"  
AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT NO. 2006-574 IN AUGUST 2015**

**WHEREAS**, during its 2006 Regular Session, the Alabama Legislature enacted Act No. 2006-574, EFFECTIVE July 1, 2006, which provides an exemption of the state sales and use tax for certain non-commercial purchases related to school clothing and supplies during the first full weekend in August of each year; and

**WHEREAS**, Act No. 2006-574 authorizes the county commission to provide for an exemption of county sales and use taxes for purchases of items covered by the Act during the same time period in which the state sales and use tax exemption is in place, provided a resolution to that effect is adopted at least thirty days prior to 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday in August; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chambers County Commission has affirmatively voted to grant the exemption of county sales and use taxes on purchases covered by Act No. 2006-574 during the first weekend of August 2015, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on August 7, 2015 and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday, August 9, 2015, the first full weekend of August in 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, *Code of Alabama 1975*, § 11-51-210(e), requires that the county commission notify the Alabama Department of Revenue of any new local tax or amendment to an existing local tax levy at least 30 days prior to the effective date of the change; and

**WHEREAS**, the exemption of certain county sales and use taxes for the first full weekend of August 2015 herein adopted by the county commission is an amendment to the county's sales and use tax levy warranting notice to the Alabama Department of Revenue as provided in *Code of Alabama 1975*, § 11-51-210(e);

**WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAMBERS COUNTY COMMISSION** that it does hereby provide for an exemption of the county sales and use tax on purchases of items covered by Act No. 2006-574 beginning at 12:01 a.m. on August 7, 2015 and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday, August 9, 2015.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of the June 1, 2015 meeting of the Chambers County Commission, and be immediately forwarded to the Alabama Department of Revenue in compliance with *Code of Alabama 1975*, § 11-51-210(e).




