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**7.5 Ton, Single Drum, Vibratory Roller (Pre Owned)**

**GENERAL**

It is the intent of these specifications to describe a pre-owned 7.5 Ton, single drum, vibratory roller. Should the manufacturer's current published data or specifications exceed these standards, the manufacturer's standards shall be considered minimum and shall be furnished. All integral parts not specifically mentioned in the scope of these specifications that are necessary to provide a complete working unit shall be furnished.

The use of specific names or numbers in the specifications is not intended to restrict the bidder or any seller or manufacturer, but is intended solely for the purpose of indicating the type, size, and quality of equipment considered best adapted to the uses of Chambers County.

**BID SUBMITTAL FORM**

Each bidder must submit his or her bid on the Bid Submittal Form included in the invitation to bid package. All written warranties to be submitted shall be attached to the Bid Submittal Form.

**BID PRICE AND PAYMENT**

Chambers County reserves the right to inspect and run the machine for up to 10 hours to ensure that all components of the machine, including those specified below, operate and function properly. Any items not functioning properly, as identified by Chambers County, shall be corrected at the bidder's expense, prior to payment being made by Chambers County. Chambers County shall make payment within 30 days of successful inspection, not to exceed 45 days of delivery or pick up.

**MANUALS**

The unit shall be provided with one (1) copy of the operator and part's manual.

**PURCHASING AND DELIVERY**

Award recommendations will be made at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the Chambers County Commission in July 2015. Pending Commission approval, purchase order will be made as soon thereafter. Bidders shall make equipment available for pick up or delivery within **45 days** of receipt of purchase order.

**STANDARD EQUIPMENT AND SPECIFICATIONS**

Standard equipment shall include but not be limited to:

- Year: **2007 or newer**
- Engine: Four (4) cylinder, Turbocharged Diesel Engine capable of producing a minimum of 80 horsepower  
**-Maximum 850 hours of Operation**
- Weight  
(Standard Operating): Based on the factory operating weight only. No additional weights can be added.  
-Minimum of 15,500 lbs.
- Starting System: Unit shall be equipped with a 12 volt electrical system
- Drive: The unit shall be equipped with a hydrostatic drive system on both rear wheels and drum.
- Drum: Drum shall be smooth with scraper bar and interchangeable padfoot scraper teeth. Shall include a two (2) piece clamp on or bolt on shell kit that will convert the smooth drum into a padfoot drum without changing the hydraulic system. The drum shall be 66 inches in width.
- Vibration: The unit shall be vibratory with two settings able to supply the following:

- Fuel Tank: The unit shall be equipped with a minimum 47 gallon capacity fuel tank.

- Brakes: Unit shall be equipped with Hydrostatic Service Brakes and Parking Brakes.
- Tires: Unit shall be equipped with minimum 6 ply, 14.9 x 24 tires that track within drum width.
- Operator’s Platform: Unit shall include: ROPS Canopy, skid resistant operator platform, lockable control panel, suspension seat, and safety rails.
- Other Features: Unit shall include the following: horn; gauges and or warning lights for engine oil pressure, coolant temperature, hydraulic oil temperature, hour meter, and fuel; back-up alarm; emergency stop; and oil level sight gauges.

**If you are unable to furnish items as specified and desire to offer a substitute, please give full description of the items offered as substitutes, otherwise your quotations will not be considered. If no exception is made on bid sheet, it will be assumed that the bidder is offering the articles specified. Bidders must indicate the brand or make, mileage, and hours of items they propose to furnish.**
