**Planing (Milling) of Existing Pavement Bid**

*By submitting this bid, the bidder agrees to honor the following Specifications to the Chambers County Highway Department and all Municipalities within Chambers County electing to participate in this bid.*

All construction work shall meet the most current revision of the ALDOT specifications and /or approved by the Chambers County Engineer or Municipality Designee. In addition, the following additional specifications and/or amendments to Section 408 in the ALDOT specifications shall be met. (Note: The following items and subsequent bid prices shall in no way affect any project let on contract by Chambers County or Municipality within Chambers County.) All items shall be bid for any location in Chambers County including its Municipalities.

The Contractor shall furnish all traffic control including but not limited to construction signs, flagmen, and pilot car necessary to provide for the safety of the public and construction crews and also to safeguard the integrity of the construction being performed. The Traffic Control Plan shall be in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD Latest Edition). The contractor will not be allowed to begin work until this Plan has been reviewed and approved by the Chambers County Engineer or Municipality Designee.

The Contractor shall thoroughly clean the planed surface with a power broom or other approved equipment to remove all pavement material, to the required depth, that may have been missed by the Planing Machine and remove any fine material or dust particles left due to the planing operation.

***The following requirements shall be met for Items 1 and 2:*** It shall be the Responsibility of the Chambers County Highway Department or Municipality to Transport, Stockpile, or otherwise dispose of the removed pavement material. The Contractor shall remove, by planing (milling), the existing pavement and load the Chambers County or Municipality Trucks in a continuous operation utilizing only a portion of one lane of Traffic. For these pay items, work will only be allowed during the normal operations of the County or Municipality. The Chambers County Highway Department operates Monday – Thursday, 6 AM to 4:30 PM CST.

If no exception is made on bid sheet, it will be assumed that the bidder is offering the articles specified. Bidders must indicate the brand or make of items they propose to furnish.**
